#### DISTRICT ENROLLMENT REQUIREMENT

The principals shall verify the ages of students who are enrolling in the district for the first time. A certified state birth certificate is required, plus all students must meet state immunization requirements.

Age Requirements:

- To attend PPCD, children must be three years old and meet state requirements.
- To attend Pre-Kindergarten, children must be four years old on or before September 1<sup>st</sup> of the current school year and meet state requirements.
- To attend Kindergarten, children must be five years old on or before September 1<sup>st</sup> of the current school year.
- To attend First Grade, children must be six years old on or before September 1<sup>st</sup> of the current school year.

#### **BAD WEATHER INFORMATION**
